

PORTA ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS 2010-2011

Supply Lists for Preschool – 6th Grade

The following is a list of general supplies, individual teachers may require a few extra items.

PRESCHOOL

- 5 boxes LARGE crayons—8 pack
- 8 glue sticks
- 3 boxes Kleenex
- 1 pair blunt edge FISKAR scissors
- 3 rectangular containers of baby wipes
- 1 box quart size Ziploc bags
- 1 box gallon Ziploc bags
- 1 box snack size Ziploc bags
- Large book bag (must be able to fit 8x10" papers)
- \$5.00 /month for snacks (Checks to Petersburg Elem)

KINDERGARTEN

- Crayola Crayons—5 boxes of 24 basic colors (regular size—no “fat” crayons)
- Elmer’s all purpose glue stick (12)
- Pocket folders (5) - folder with two horizontal pockets—NO Trapper Keepers
- 6 Pencils—No. 2 lead—regular size preferably *Eagle* or *American*—other brands do not sharpen well and break easily
- Pencil box (small plastic w/snap lid)
- Crayola or Prang paint sets— 8 basic colors
- Fiskars scissors (metal blades)
- Pink eraser
- Basic lightweight stereo headphones, adjustable headband, 4’ shielded cord, 3.5 mm stereo plug (for computer lab)
- Paint shirt—(adult t-shirt is preferred) please put child’s name on shirt
- Book bag (no wheeled book bags)
- Folding vinyl resting mat (Kindermat)
- Crayola Markers—large washable (8 basic colors)
- 2 boxes Kleenex (to be shared)
- Boys—Ziploc gallon freezer bags and Clorox bleach wipes
- Girls—Ziploc sandwich bags and hand sanitizer

FIRST GRADE

Please unwrap all packaging and label all supplies before sending to school.

- 1 large plastic pencil box (7” x 11”)
- Pencils—No. 2 lead—regular size (4 dozen) preferably *Eagle* or *American*—other brands do not sharpen well and break easily.
- Crayola washable markers (3 sets)—8 or 10 basic colors, wide tip—NO FLUORESCENT
- Crayons—24 count is plenty (4 sets)
- 1 watercolor paint set
- 1 spiral notebook, wide-ruled
- 2 bottles Elmer’s white glue (not “no-run” kind)
- 12 glue sticks
- Book Bag (no wheeled book bags)
- Erasers—pencil top and 2” or 3” pink erasers
- 1 pair Fiskars scissors
- 4 pocket folders (sturdy enough to stand alone)
- Set of headphones—3.5 mm stereo plug with 4’ cord (students may have a pair from last year)
- Paint shirt—please put child’s name on shirt
- 2 boxes of facial tissues (to be shared)
- Girls—1 box Ziploc sandwich bags and 12 oz. bottle (or larger) hand sanitizer
- Boys—1 box Ziploc gallon bags and 1 box antibacterial wipes

SECOND GRADE

Please unwrap all packaging and label all supplies before sending to school.

- 1 package cap erasers
- 2 plastic pencil boxes (5” x 8”)
- 5 pocket folders (3 yellow, 2 your choice)
- 2 pairs of Fiskars scissors
- 8 white glue sticks (and 1 bottle of glue)
- 48 No. 2 pencils—NO INK PENS
- 3 boxes crayons—24 count
- 2 sets washable markers (1 wide tip, 1 thin tip)
- 6 erasers—2” or 3” pink or green
- Crayola or Prang paint set—8 basic colors
- 12 inch ruler with inches and centimeters
- Art shirt—please put child’s name on shirt
- Book bag—(no wheeled book bags)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex (to be shared)
- Set of headphones—3.5 mm stereo plug w/ 4’ cord (students may have a pair from last year)
- Boys—1 box zipper bags (sandwich size) and 1 box of wet wipes
- Girls—1 box of zipper bags (gallon size) and 1 bottle antibacterial hand sanitizer

NO BOOK BAGS with WHEELS; regular backpacks that fit into lockers only.

All students need PE shoes, an art shirt, and a three-prong pocket folder w/ brass fasteners for art.
