

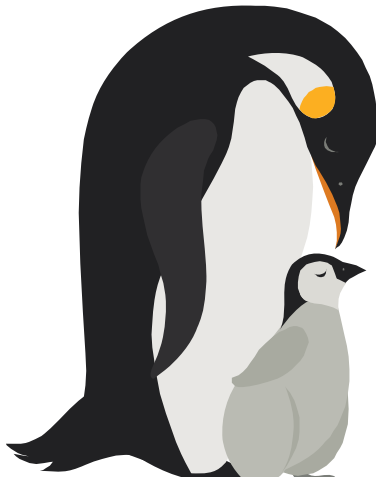
Miss Lambert's Classroom Newsletter

Language

We have been very busy working on writing letters and learning their sounds. We have now learned all the letters. We are working on building (spelling) and reading words using these sounds. This week we learned the sound the digraph "th" makes like in: that, there, bath, or math.

We are also learning high-frequency words that occur frequently while reading. Students need to be able to read these words. High-Frequency words are listed on back of the newsletter.

Math

We just finished our unit on measurement: length, capacity, and weight. Now, we are learning about solids including: cylinders, spheres, boxes, pyramids, & cones. We will also be learning about shapes including: squares, rectangles, triangles, & circles. Finally, this unit will cover sharing which includes: halves, equal parts, & making equal groups.
