Language

We have been very busy working on writing letters and learning their sounds. We have been working with both short a (rat, fan) and short e (bed, leg) words. Our recent vocabulary words include: cooperation, enormous, hatchling, migrate, wings, stroll, scamper, and tend. Be sure to ask your student what these mean!

We are also learning high-frequency words that occur frequently while reading. Students need to be able to read these words. High-Frequency words are listed on back of the newsletter.
