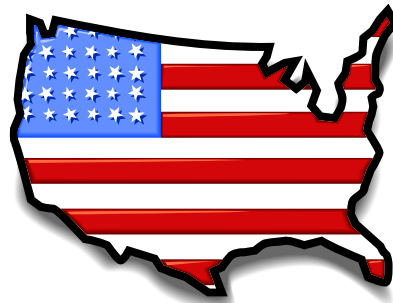
Math
