

# Miss Lambert's Classroom Newsletter

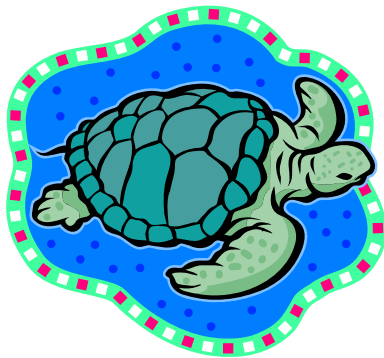

We have been very busy working on writing letters and learning their sounds.

## Math

We just finished our first math unit on position and classification. Part of this unit involved learning left and right. This can be difficult for students, so students should continue to practice left and right at home.

Our next math unit will be on sorting and graphing.

We also have been working on numbers. We practice writing numbers 1-10. We also count by 10's each day to 100. These are both skills students can practice at home!
